

## Eligibility of SWANA Mid-Atlantic Chapter Scholarships (as well as the SWANA International and Robert P. Stearns/SCS Engineers scholarships)

A candidate must be sponsored by a Mid-Atlantic Chapter member or shall be a Mid-Atlantic Chapter Student Member, in good standing at the time of application, selection, and award. The following table summarizes the available scholarships at the Chapter and International level based on a candidates' "relationship" to the Chapter and the year of college they are entering:
